The Craig's Hut Story

Craig's Hut was home to Jim Craig, hero in the movie "Man From Snowy River". Built as a movie prop to last several months in 1981, it soon became a popular tourist attraction for those who have seen the film. The vehicle battling the rough bush tracks into Craig's Hut, in addition to time and weather, have taken their toll ad the hut became unsafe after ten years.

Because of its popularity as a tourist haven for both local and overseas visitors, the Mansfield Alpine Four Wheel Drive Club in conjunction with the Department of Conservation, Forests and Land, businesses in the Mansfield region, and many volunteers undertook the complete rebuilding of the Hut. Work was completed in March 1993 and the "new" Craig's Hut was officially opened by the then Minister for Conservation and Environment, The Honourable Mark Birrell, MP on April 4th, 1993.

Craig's Hut is located on Clear Hills, off Circuit Road, 19kms from Telephone Box Junction and is inaccessible to standard vehicles. Located above the snowline, it offers magnificent panoramic high country views

Craig's Hut, despite modern vehicles, is remote with no services or facilities on site. Weather conditions can change rapidly. It is because of these dramatic changes in the weather that the original cattlemen's huts were built around the high country, to provide shelter in emergency conditions. Whilst not an original, Craig's Hut also acts as a haven for travellers in summer and for snow skiers in winter.

A Dinner is held annually at Craig's Hut to raise funds for continued maintenance and for ancillary facilities such as an historical information collection, information boards, and ongoing maintenance and rehabilitation of the area.

Why "Dinner at Craig's Hut"?

Since the rebuild of Craig's Hut in 1993, there has been four "Dinner at Craig's Hut" co-ordinated by the Mansfield Alpine Four Wheel Drive Club and the Country Fire Authority Four Wheel Drive Club.

"Dinner at Craig's Hut, 1998 will be jointly convened by the Mansfield Alpine and CFA Clubs and will continue to raise funds for the maintenance and upkeep of the hut and surrounds. It is an initiative, which supports the appropriate use of Victoria's High Country and increasing co-operation fosters between all user groups. It is also intended to raise awareness of the beauty and tranquillity of the area as a tourist attraction and to promote local business such as those providing the services for the evening.

The Dinner

"Dinner at Craig's Hut" is a formal, black tie, invitation only function.

It is attended by Members of Government (all Parties), representatives of businesses from Mansfield and Mt. Buller and further afield, Department of Natural Resources and Environment staff, Parks Victoria staff, Alpine Resorts Commission staff, Journalists and Tourism Organisations.

From your motel or resort accommodation you will be transported by 4WD coaches to Craig's Hut.

There you will enjoy pre-dinner drinks and a spectacular sunset over Victoria's high country, complete with background music. At 6.30pm you will be invited to the marquee to enjoy a sumptuous meal, local wines and entertainment by a local band.

At the conclusion of the formal part of the evening you will have the choice of dancing, adjourning to the camp fire for a quiet chat or simply enjoying the peace and solitude of the high country enthralled by the myriad stars that are unseen in the city. The choice is yours....

At approximately midnight your coach will be ready to return you to your accommodation after a wonderful evening. Next morning you will awaken to the peace of the Delatite Valley and after breakfast, brace yourself for the harsh reality of life.

For you to attend an unusual event that is not easily forgotten in the beauty of the High Country.

During the evening various items will be raffled.


